Notes:

1. Mandatory transponder ownership for open license riders. Transponders can be ordered from the club or the AusCycling website
2. Subject to entries, separate male and female classes will be run except for Novice & 30+ Masters classes.
3. Riders entering two classes require two transponders.
4. Male & female Classes
5. No refunds unless:
 - a. It is found after the close of entries that a rider's nominated Class is not available, and a suitable alternative Class is not available; or
 - b. A rider is injured or becomes ill prior to the event and produces a medical certificate, in which case an administration fee will be deducted.
6. It is the rider/guardian's responsibility:
 - a. To check if an entry has been received. Entry lists will be progressively updated on the EntryBoss web site www.entryboss.cc
 - b. To ensure their entry is correct including transponder number, plate number, and class entered.
 - c. To ensure they register, check Moto sheets, attend staging on time and ride in their correct Moto.
7. Voucher Prize Pool \$150 per class. Refer Auscycling BMX Racing Technical Regulations for placing breakdown.
8. Para BMX classes to be run in accordance with Auscycling Para-Cycling technical regulations.
9. Entries will close on the 1st of Nov. 11.59pm.

Please note, there will be parking restrictions during the event. Please park in designated car parks as council have advised they will be patrolling the area.

No parking or car movement inside track grounds during event times. Authorised vehicles only

Rules & Format

- THUNDERDOME is a Bronze Auscycling event
- Auscycling/UCI rules 2026 applies
- Age Determination on 31st December 2026
- At close of entries four (4) riders constitute a class
- Format: Six (6) Moto/final (quarter/semi finals as required)
 - Four (4) Motos run on Saturday and two (2) Motos and final on Sunday
 - Racing is conducted over two (2) days, with points through Motos, dead man semis and dead man finals.
 - Invitational finals included for all Challenge Classes
 - Classes of 8 riders or less will have Seven (7) Motos
 - Mini Wheelers & Sprockets: Seven (7) Motos
- Acceptance of entry is subject to final approval of organising committee.
- All riders must hold a Mini Wheeler, Sprocket, 4 Month or Open Auscycling license.
- Riders who wish to qualify for the Top 8 Shootout must enter Superclass or Super ladies.
 - For applicable classes, time trials will be run prior to commencement of racing on Saturday
 - The eight (8) fastest riders in each shootout class will qualify for the Shootout final, which will be held immediately after the conclusion of the fourth moto on Saturday.
- King & Queen of Thunderdome will be awarded to the rider with the fastest lap time in Superclass Men & Ebony's 14+ Super Ladies respectively
 - Only lap times in motos will count
- Thunderdome is a smoke & alcohol free event, patrons who do not abide by this will be removed from the venue.
- No pets allowed
